**G.S.R. 78B.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 29 of the Indian Boiler Act, 1923 (Central Act No. 5 of 1923), the State Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Boiler Rules, 1954, the same having been previously published in Rajasthan Raj-Patra Extraordinary Part-3 (Kha) dated 23-9-2010 as required by sub-section (1) of 31 of the said Act, namely:-

**RULES**

**1. Short title and commencement.**—(i) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Boilers (Amendment) Rules, 2010.

(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their final publication in the Official Gazettee.

**2. Substitution of Rule 38.**—The existing rule 38 of the Rajasthan Boilers Rules, 1954 shall be substituted by the following rule 38 and rule 38A, namely:-

**"38. Fees for registration and inspection.**—(1) Fees for registration and inspection of boilers shall be levied in accordance with the following scale :-

For boiler rating exceeding 10 square meters	720
For Boiler Rating exceeding 10 sq.m. but not exceeding 30	960
For Boiler Rating exceeding 30 sq.m. but not exceeding 50	1080
For Boiler Rating exceeding 50 sq.m. but not exceeding 70	1320
For Boiler Rating exceeding 70 sq.m. but not exceeding 90	1560
For Boiler Rating exceeding 90 sq.m. but not exceeding 110	1800
For Boiler Rating exceeding 110 sq.m. but not exceeding 200	2040
For Boiler Rating exceeding 200 sq.m. but not exceeding 400	2280

For Boiler Rating exceeding 400 sq.m. but not exceeding 600	2640
For Boiler Rating exceeding 600 sq.m. but not exceeding 800	2880
For Boiler Rating exceeding 800 sq.m. but not exceeding 1000	3240
For Boiler Rating exceeding 1000 sq.m. but not exceeding 1200	3840
For Boiler Rating exceeding 1200 sq.m. but not exceeding 1400	4320
For Boiler Rating exceeding 1400 sq.m. but not exceeding 1600	5040
For Boiler Rating exceeding 1600 sq.m. but not exceeding 1800	5400
For Boiler Rating exceeding 1800 sq.m. but not exceeding 2000	6000
For Boiler Rating exceeding 2000 sq.m. but not exceeding 2200	6480
For Boiler Rating exceeding 2200 sq.m. but not exceeding 2400	7200
For Boiler Rating exceeding 2400 sq.m. but not exceeding 2600	7560
For Boiler Rating exceeding 2600 sq.m. but not exceeding 2800	8160
For Boiler Rating exceeding 2800 sq.m. but not exceeding 3000	8640

Above 3000 square meters for every 200 square meters or part thereof an additional fee of Rs. 240/- shall be charge:

Provided that when any owner is willing to accept a renewed certificate for less than twelve months in order to approximate the date of annual inspection to the date on which other boilers in the locality are inspected, a certificate for such period less than twelvemonths as may be necessary for such approximation of date may be granted at a reduced fee to be calculated at one twelfth of the ordinary fee for each full month, portion of a month not being reckoned.

**Boilers and parts thereof under fabrication.**-Fee for inspection of boilers and parts thereof under fabrication shall be the same as prescribed in Regulation 395A:

Provided that the Chief Inspector may require the manufacturer or the fabricator to pay a fresh fee equal to the usual inspection fee in any particular case where due to his fault or neglect the visit paid by any Inspector for Examination was fruitless

**38A. Fee for Examination of Welders.**-For the qualification or re-qualification tests of Welders, engaged in welding of boilers and steam pipes under construction,

erection and fabrication or their repairs in accordance with the requirements of Chapter XIII of the Regulation, a fee of Rs. 500/- shall be charged. Additional charges for the plants, materials the preparation of test pieces and the mechanical test shall be borne by the Welder or his employer.”
